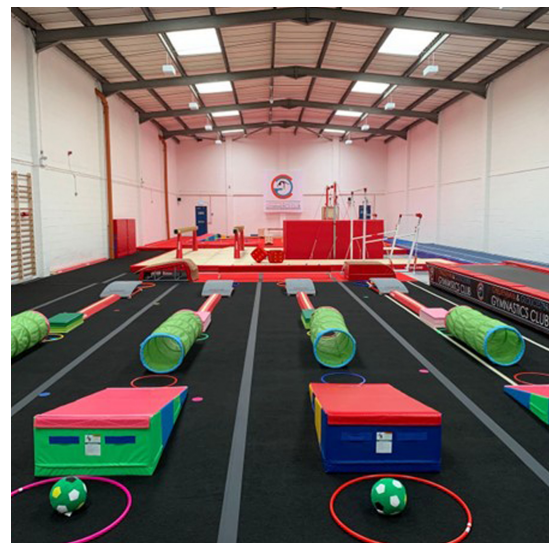

Accessibility information?

Parking: The club has space out the front for visitors to pull in and drop off participants. There is also a car park in the corner of the estate if there is no room out the front. Please do not park in front of other units or in bays reserved for other businesses.

The area directly in front of the doors should be kept clear for disabled parking.

Ramp access: There is one small step to enter the building from the street level. The club has a fold-out ramp which can be deployed for visitors with additional accessibility needs.

Accessible toilet: The club has an accessible toilet with baby-changing facilities and hygiene bins.

Sensory information: Our gymnastics activities take place in a large, specially equipped facility. In order to heat the facility to a safe temperature, the building has a large fan heater which is noisy and can stimulate children with additional sensory needs. The club in general is a noisy space full of colourful equipment which may cause some discomfort for those with additional sensory needs.
